<u>Current vacancy is for a Microbiologist III – Supervisor in the Health and Human Services Department.</u>

Grade Level I – Performs the duties of the classification under close supervision.

Grade Level II – Performs the duties of the classification under general supervision; may act in a lead capacity over Microbiologist I's and other technical/professional staff. Two years of recent experience as a certified Public Health Microbiologist in a public health laboratory. A Master's Degree in Medical or Public Health Microbiology or closely related field may be substituted for one year of the required experience.

Grade Level III – Supervises Microbiologist I's and II's and other laboratory staff and acts as the Technical Supervisor in accordance with the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA) or the Technical/QA Manager in accordance with the accreditation guidelines by the American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA). Grade III requires current: (1) qualification as a Technical Supervisor in accordance with CLIA; or (2) qualification as a Technical//QA Manager in accordance with accreditation guidelines by AIHA.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Performs and complies with Testing Personnel responsibilities in accordance with the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA), Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (ELAP), California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA), and American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA) standards; performs microbiological, molecular, and serological testing of human and environmental samples for the detection and identification of infectious disease agents; performs chemical testing of environmental samples for the detection of environmental and biological hazards; performs toxicology (blood lead) testing; performs new test validation; performs data analyses; utilizes judgment in resolving equivocal or indeterminate results; prepares routine lab reports; enters patient information and demographics on the laboratory's information management system; performs quality control and quality assurance procedures;

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complies with safety rules and regulations while working in the laboratory; participates in special training for new procedures and assists in the development of procedure manuals; performs preventive maintenance procedures on equipment and instruments; troubleshoots equipment and instrument problems; complies with regulatory requirements; may supervise lab staff and act as the Technical Supervisor; performs other related duties as required.
